DONNINGTON VALLEY GOLF CLUB - LOCAL RULES

1. OUT OF BOUNDS

- a. All land outside the boundary of the course including; Hotel grounds, car parks, driveway, Club House, patio and surrounds over the wall bordering 9th and 18th greens and steps.
- b. Any area defined by white marker posts.

2. PENALTY AREAS

Penalty Areas within the course are defined by Yellow Stakes. or Red Stakes

3. PROTECTION OF YOUNG TREES IDENTIFIED BY STAKES OR PLASTIC SLEEVES

If such a tree interferes with a player's stance or intended swing, the ball must be lifted, without penalty, and dropped in accordance with Rule 16.1b. The ball may be cleaned when so lifted.

4. INTEGRAL PART OF COURSE

The wall between the pond and the green on the 9th Hole - relief can be obtained with a one-stroke penalty - Rule 19.2.

5. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS

- a. All clearly defined pathways including logged edging.
- b. Greenkeepers' equipment, huts/ buildings on the course and earth dumps.
- c. Sprinklers, water pipes & control boxes.
- d. All protective fences (except where marked white meaning O.O.B.).
- e. The sculptures throughout the course.
- f. Sprinkler heads close to putting green, Model Local Rule F-5 applies. See notice outside Pro Shop.
- g. Grass collection boxes.

6. GROUND UNDER REPAIR

- Relief must be taken from areas of GUR (Rule 16.1b).
- a. Vehicle tracks on the course will be treated as Ground Under Repair (this does not include faint impressions).
- b. Any area defined by a white painted border.
- c. Any clearly defined flowerbeds
- d. French drains on the left hand side of

the 1st fairway/approach & around the Hole.

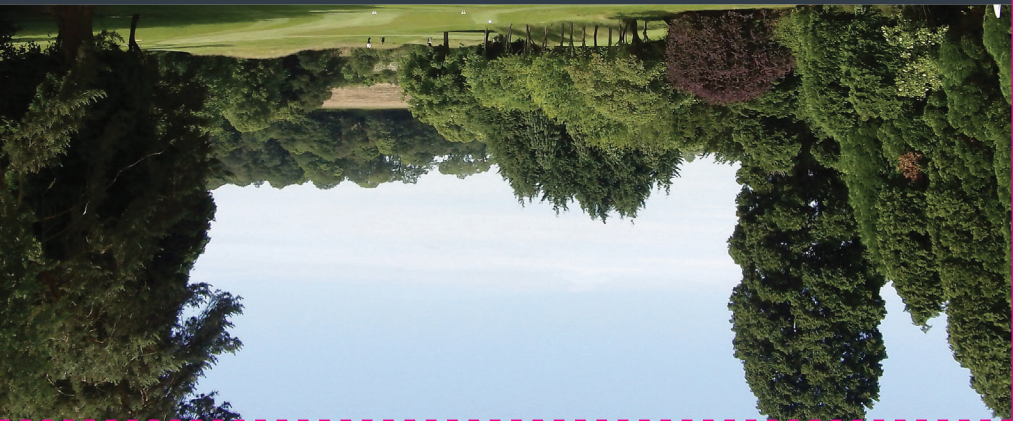
RULES OF GOLF - RULE 1. The Game, Players Conduct and the Rules. The Rules relating to Dress code, Courtesy, Priority and Care of the Course must be observed by all players at all times. Golf shoes are mandatory as is correct golfing attire. Always keep up with the group in front of you, if a group is waiting for you, due to you falling behind, you must allow it to play through. Pitch marks must be repaired, divots must be replaced, and bunkers must be raked.

THE USE OF MOBILE PHONES ON THE COURSE FOR THE USE OF A GOLF SAT NAV APP IS PERMITTED, HOWEVER USING THE PHONE FOR CALLS ON THE COURSE OR IN THE CLUBHOUSE IS NOT PERMITTED.

The club encourages all players to play 'Ready Golf' when safe to do so, to ensure pace of play is at an acceptable speed.
